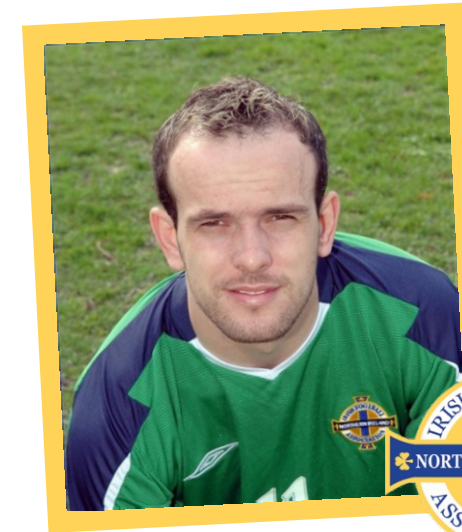

Tom was involved with the work of BCM for more than 60 years including the first after-school meetings in a hut in Wallace Avenue; the move later to the Boys' Hall in Wardsborough Road; the first Bible Club Rally in Lisburn Orange Hall in 1951; and the spread of BCM fellowships throughout the area. Tom left his teaching job in 1967 and with his wife Joan they started Bible Clubs in many areas of Lisburn and in other towns from Omagh to Comber and Ballymena. They took on the work of Mullartown House when BCM purchased it in 1978, a role which lasted more than twenty years. Although officially retired, Tom was still involved with camps until just a few years ago. Tom was called home to be with the Lord on 26th February 2016.
